General Guidelines for Session [2026-27]

Examination Schedule

1. Three periodic tests and two terms will be conducted in an academic year. (The best 2 periodic tests count for overall final result).
2. Mid Term Examination will be conducted in September and the Annual Term Examination will be conducted in March according to the given syllabus.
3. The Periodic Test-1 and The Periodic Test-2 will be conducted in the first semester and The Periodic Test-3 and Second Term will be conducted in the second semester.
4. The Periodic test will be of 30 marks, second term will be of 40 marks and the Annual Exam will be of 50 marks [Pre Nur to Fifth].
5. The Periodic test will be of 30 marks, second term and the Annual Exam will be of 80 marks [Sixth to Eighth].
6. The Duration of Periodic Test will be of 1 hour, second term and the Annual Term will be of 2 hours. (Pre Nursery to Fifth).
7. The Duration of Periodic Test will be of 1 hour, second term and the Annual Term will be of 2.5 hours. (sixth to eighth class).

8. Calculation of the Final Result – 20 % of Periodic Assessments + 80 % of Yearly Examinations.

Examination and Promotion Policy –

Annual Examination – (i) Entire syllabus of 2nd Term (**Nur – V Class**).

(ii) 10 % covering of 1st term significant topics + entire syllabus of 2nd Term (**VI Class**).

(iii) 20 % covering of 1st term significant topics + entire syllabus of 2nd Term (**VII Class**).

(iv) 30 % covering of 1st term significant topics + entire syllabus of 2nd Term **(VIII Class)**.

(v) Entire syllabus covered in the whole year. **(IX Class)**.

(vi) Periodic Test-1 in May, Periodic Test-2 in August, Mid Term in September, Periodic Test-3 in October, Pre board-1 in December, Pre board-2 in January and the board syllabus with 100 % syllabus **(X Class)**.

9. Regular assessments of students will be done regularly throughout the academic session as per the weightage of marks given in the table.
